Cochrane Collaboration international organisation that aims to help people make well-informed decisions about healthcare by preparing, maintaining and promoting the accessibility of systematic reviews of the effects of healthcare interventions.

### The Cochrane Oral Health Group (OHG) aims to produce systematic reviews which primarily include all randomised controlled trials (RCTs) in oral health. Oral health is

broadly conceived to include the prevention, treatment and rehabilitation of oral, dental and craniofacial diseases and disorders.

The OHG is composed of persons from around the world who share an interest in developing and maintaining systematic reviews relevant to the field of oral health. Reviewers are encouraged to collaborate on reviews and the OHG is able to facilitate contacts with colleagues around the world. The group is co-ordinated by an Editorial Team who edit and assemble completed reviews into modules for inclusion in The Cochrane Library (an electronic database updated quarterly).

### OHG specialised register continues to approaching grow now records!

Essentially the register is a collection of reports of Randomised Controlled Trials (RCTs) and CCTs and associated material such as published correspondence, conference proceedings, research abstracts, etc. The register is continually being expanded as new material is identified. The foundation for its on-going development is the Cochrane Central Register of Controlled Trials (CENTRAL) contained within The Cochrane Library (an electronic library updated quarterly). Another major source of material is obtained from handsearching journals from cover to cover to identify trials not picked up by electronic searches due to lack of detail in titles and abstracts. Once identified, these trials are downloaded electronically or entered manually into the OHG Trials Register.

The register is maintained and managed from our editorial base and staff will be pleased to assist Cochrane review authors in carrying out searches of the database.

### **OHG News**

OHG wins further funding! The Department of Health England, the Group's main funding body, announced in December 2006 that the Group's current Cochrane Review Group contract is to be extended for one further year until 31 March 2010.

The OHG Newsletter has a new Editor. Philip Riley, the Administrator of the OHG, will take over from Luisa Fernandez, the Review Group Co-ordinator. It will now be released quarterly to coincide with publication dates of The Cochrane Library, and will be in a new shorter format.

- **OHG wins award!** The Department of Health England, Cochrane Incentive Scheme awarded £5000 in December 2006 for updating the review 'Routine scale and polish for periodontal health in adults'.
